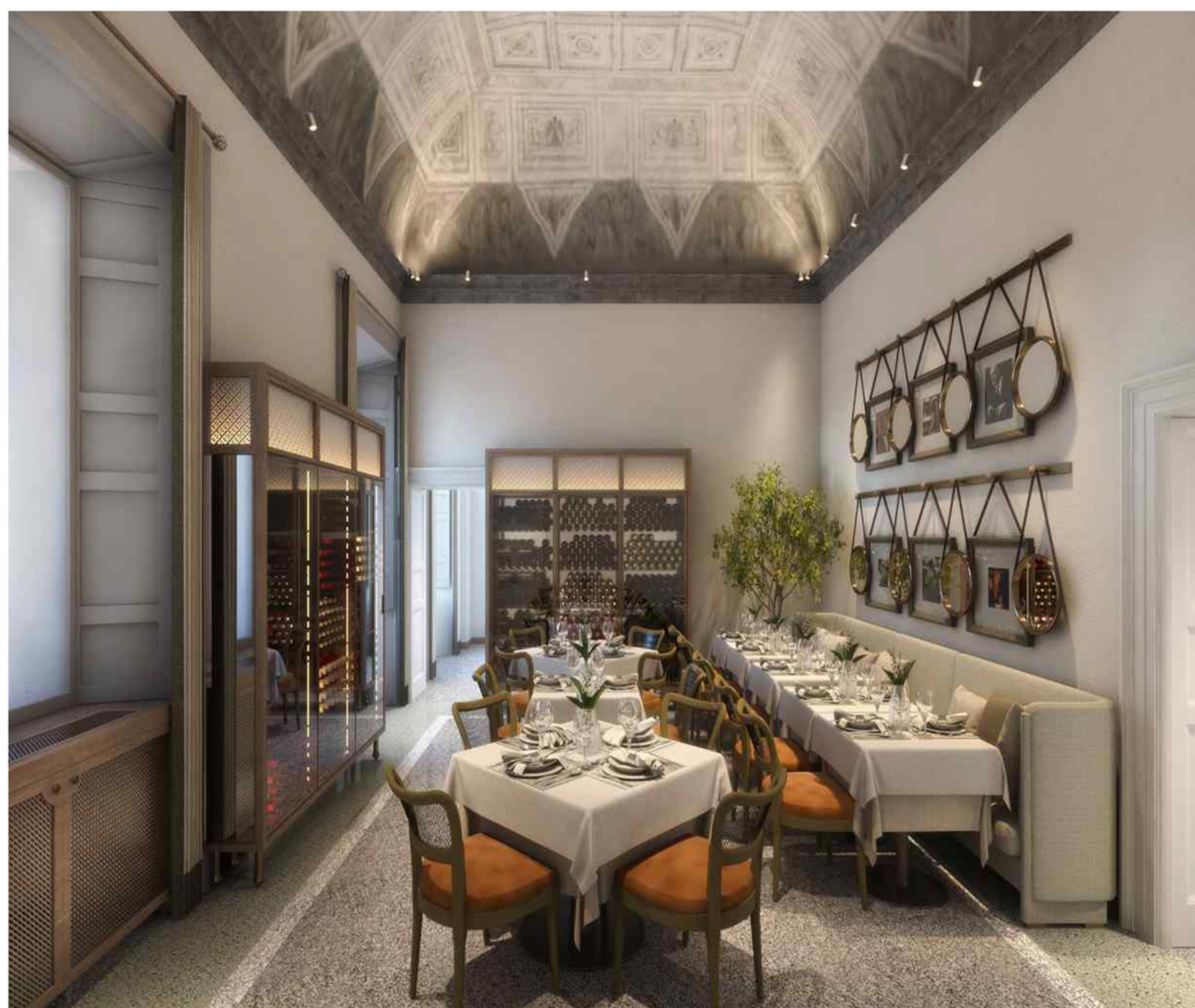


Six highlights at Milan design week

Paper Moon Giardino It would be unthinkable to visit Milan without enjoying at least one memorable [dining experience](#). During design week, the cool crowd are sure to flock to new opening Paper Moon Giardino. Set in a 200-year-old mansion in the city's [fashion](#) district, it has been designed by Ed Ng and Terence Ngan of Hong Kong studio AB Concept, who have employed a nature-inspired palette to flatter the antique frescoes and terrazzo floors. Guests can choose from one of four areas in which to dine: a grand salon, a parlour, a wine library or a courtyard garden. The menu is still being finalised, but sister restaurant Paper Moon nearby is known for simple, seasonal dishes like monkfish with tomato sauce and olives.
